
Dear Commission:

We are writing to you in hope that you will come to the aid of Lake Almanor and Butt Valley Lake in Northern California. Pacific Gas & Electric Company, in it's re-licensing attempts with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, is proposing "thermal curtains" for both lakes in order to lower the downstream temperature of the North Fork of the Feather River.
