Enclosed articles concerning PG&E's proposal to erect a 700x900 foot barrier into Lake Almanor near the intake of a large pipeline that sends water to Butt Lake hydro-electric generators. PG&E also proposes to install another barrier in Butt Lake. All of this to divert bottom cold water from Lake Almanor and Butt Lake to lower the water temperature in the Middle Fork of the Feather River where PG&E has numerous dams for power generation. They propose to lower the water temperature 1-2 or 3 degrees for the trout habitat in that section of the River. IT WON'T WORK!!! PG&E has had these dams and power generators on this River for approx. 90 years. Not in a moment of weakness, by PG&E officials, they agreed to this stupid proposal. Its never before been tested in any lake. Only models by Univ of Idaho Engineering improved. To erect this curtain and take cold water and send it down Butt Creek to the Middle Fork of the Feather. Approx 20 to 25 miles down the river. ... and all cold water

not during the summer months.

DG+E could care less!! The rate payer and share holders are going to pay 40 million to 50 million for this unproven project. An exorbitant estimated cost, not including the annual maintenance.
