Recent proposed changes to the Settlement Agreement of April 21, 2004 will have a devastating effect on Lake Almanor, a lake which is second only to Lake Tahoe in its importance to California.

The negative effect on the water quality and fishery which is already challenged by climate change will be very substantial and will turn Almanor into an undesirable sump. As an Almanor resident of fifty years this the greatest challenge we have ever faced.


The Lake is at a marginal level in temperature already. Any further increase will turn the water quality green all summer and will devastate the fishery which is more significant that the fishery on the lower Feather River.

The proposed changes by the California State Water Resource Control Board are the result **back room political pressures** by a handful of influential old time trout fisherman. They should not be allowed to destroy one of the most valuable recreation lakes in California.

The idea of making a project of draining the cool water of Lake Almanor is obscene.
