Dear Mr. Livingston:

We received Mr. Bill Zemke's May 20, 2002 letter concerning the placement of natural hazard markers on Lake Almanor and Bucks Lake Reservoirs, FERC Project Nos. 2105 and 619, respectively. This letter supplements the information presented in the Company's February 5, 2002 letter. As Mr. Zemke indicates in the most recent letter, the inventory of potential natural hazards historically marked by the Plumas County Sheriff (Sheriff) at the lakes is now complete, and a listing is provided in Exhibit A to the May 20th letter.

The Company's May 20th letter also includes information on the Company's plan of action for the 2002 recreation season. The measures discussed in the letter appear to be complete, and are adequate. It is noted that the Company is currently negotiating a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Sheriff regarding cooperation and coordination of hazard markings at Lake Almanor and Bucks Lake. On completion of that MOU a revised Public Safety Plan to reflect any agreements that may be reached with the Sheriff will be prepared.

The Company's response to our March 5, 2002 letter is satisfactory, and the Company's plan of action is acceptable. Thank you for your timely response in this public
